I am requesting funding for the Milford Borough Central Sewage and Stormwater project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is Milford Borough, located at 500 Broad Street, Milford, PA 18337. The funding would be used for central sewage in Milford Borough, Milford Township, Westfall Township, and Matamoras Borough. The project will connect the commercial districts in these communities to an existing plant allowing restaurants, hotels, existing offices, and manufacturing facilities to expand. The county government is also housed along this corridor, and this will provide a foundation for continued and expanded governmental services including legal and court functions. The current on-lot situation has resulted in several losses for economic growth in this corridor. A strong infrastructure is the foundation of economic growth. The project also includes Storm Water rebuild in Milford Borough. Most of the existing stormwater pipes in Milford Borough are constructed of galvanized steel which have deteriorated over time and have the bottom portions completely rusted out and need to be replaced.
