I am requesting funding for the Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority East Side Interceptor in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Wyoming Valley Sanitary Authority, located at 1000 Wilkes-Barre Street, Hanover Township, PA 18706. The funding would be used to update 1,147 linear feet of interceptor line running under the City of Wilkes-Barre. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure reliable wastewater service, eliminate risk of raw sewage release, eliminate risk of pipe collapse, and protect public health and the environment.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
