I am requesting funding for the SR 6 Over Wallenpaupack Creek Bridge Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) located at 55 Keystone Industrial Park, Dunmore, Pennsylvania 18512. The funding would be used to rehabilitate the bridge on State Route 6 (G.A.R. Highway) that spans over Wallenpaupack Creek in Pike and Wayne Counties.
