I am requesting funding for the SR 590 Paving Project in fiscal year 2023. The entity to receive funding for this project is PennDOT District 4, located at 55 Keystone Industrial Park, Dunmore, PA 18512. The funding would be used for resurfacing on State Route 590 in Lackawaxen Township, Pike County. The project length is 9.1 miles from the Wayne County Line to Towpath Road. Typical pavement failures on SR 590 include cracking, potholes, depressions, rutting, and raveling. The proposed project will improve pavement deficiencies and provide a smoother riding surface, therefore decreasing the cost of ongoing roadway maintenance.
